

6. Establishment of a Recurring Automatic Withdraw (RAW) from a checking or savings account

Payments can be automatically withdrawn from your checking or savings account on a monthly basis. To set up this option you must register and set up an account with ExpertPay (www.expertpay.com). There is no charge for payments sent to PA SCDU, but there may be a one-time registration fee of \$2.50. Please allow seven (7) days for the payment to be received at PA SCDU. The ExpertPay Customer Service number is 1-800-403-0879.

7. Payment made by credit card over the telephone

A payment can be made by a Visa card, MasterCard, or Discover card by calling 1-800-955-2305. A convenience fee will be charged to your credit card on top of the amount you are paying towards support each time this method is used. This is not a recurring payment. The payment is processed immediately, but will take around 7 to 10 days until it is received by the state of Pennsylvania.

There are several methods by which you are able to make payments towards your open support case. It is important to keep your support case current to avoid enforcement methods beginning such as driver's license suspension, recreational license suspension, tax refund intercept, and contempt of court, in addition to numerous other enforcement measures. Each payment method is different. Some methods take several days to process and some have fees associated with them. A short description of each payment method shall follow. If you have any additional questions, you can call the Domestic Relations Office at the number on the front of this pamphlet.

1. Check or money order sent to the Pennsylvania State Collection & Disbursement Unit (PA SCDU)

The preferred method of payment is a check or money order sent to PA SCDU. The address for PA SCDU can be found on the last page of this pamphlet. When sending a payment to PA SCDU, make sure to include at least three identifiers. Identifiers can include member number, social security number, etc. This is to ensure that the payment is being processed to the proper member. PA SCDU does not accept starter checks. The time frame of the posting of the payment will vary depending on mailing time.

2. Payment by cash, check, or money order at the Domestic Relations Office (DRO)

Payments can be provided to either DRO site in the form of cash, check or money order. Any check or money order should be made out to Cambria County Domestic Relations. Should a check be returned for any reason, you are fully responsible to pay a recoupment payment to the DRO immediately and will be responsible for any fees that may occur. No further check payments will be accepted as well. A payment made at the office prior to 1:45 PM will be posted that day. Any payments received between 1:45 PM to closing will post to the case the following day.

3. Payment by credit or debit card at the Domestic Relations Office (DRO)

Payments can be provided at either of the Cambria County Domestic Relations Office in Ebensburg or Johnstown by credit or debit card. Mastercard, Visa, Discover, and American Express are expected. There is a 2.95% convenience fee on the payment that you provide. This convenience fee is collected by a third party provider (Value Payment Systems) and will not be credited to your support case(s). These payments are processed immediately and are posted to the case once the monies are completely processed, which is typically 2-3 days.

4. Payments made by debit or credit card at www.childsupportbillpay.com/cambria-pa

Payments may also be made online with a debit or credit at www.childsupportbillpay.com/cambria-pa. Mastercard, Visa, Discover, and American Express are accepted. There is a 2.95% convenience fee on the payment that you provide. This convenience fee is collected by a third party provider (Value Payment Systems) and will not be credited to your support case(s). These payments are processed immediately and are posted to the case(s) once the monies are completely processed, which is typically 2-3 days.

5. Payment made at www.e-ChildsPay.com by credit card

A payment can be made by Visa card, MasterCard, or Discover card by visiting www.e-ChildsPay.com. The website is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. A convenience fee will be charged to your credit card each time you use this method on top of what you are paying towards the support order. The payment is processed immediately, but will take around 7 to 10 days until it is received by the state of Pennsylvania.
