The Cambria County Retirement Fund is pleased to present its annual report of the County Retirement Fund activities for the year ending December 31, 2010.

The Controllers Office and the Retirement Board noted a busy year as we saw an increase in our assets and the further diversification of our fund. The economy during 2010 tried to advance and in some aspects made gains, while in others, such as oil, we saw increases in pricing through the end of the year. Consumer confidence seemed to stabilize with unemployment holding around the 9.5% - 10% level. Domestic production rebounded and exports seem to be on the rise.

Once again, we have summarized the expenses and revenues of the Retirement Fund on the next few pages. You will notice that during 2010 we made some changes to the managers of the fund, and our demand for all of them to increase their values continues. Overall we have been optimistic about their performance. Our fund started the year at \$148,350,306 and ended the year at \$160,002,302. 2010 was the first year for the Fund after the sale of the County's nursing home, Laurel Crest Manor, which resulted in a large increase in the number of County Retirees. As of this writing, the number of County Retirees is 876 individuals.

In 2010, the County General Fund made a contribution of \$2,265,930 to the retirement fund to help maintain the solvency of the Fund for all retirees. In the beginning of 2010 we started out with our fund at a little over \$149 million. We knew that 2010 would be a busy year in the retirement department because of the potential number of retirees as a result of the sale of Laurel Crest Manor. At the end of 2009 we had 770 retirees, at the end of 2010 the total was 868 that is an increase of 98 individuals. The monthly retiree payroll is approximately \$675,001 per month. The monthly retiree hospitalization cost is approximately \$259,893 per month which computes to over \$3.1 million per year, and is fully funded by the County's general fund.

In 2010, the Cambria County Retirement Fund paid out a total of \$11,336,114.39, which consisted of the following: \$7,721,203.20 for retiree payroll, \$3,206,152.45 in withdrawals for individuals who left County employment and \$408,758.74 in death benefits.

In conclusion, as we continue to be stewards of the County Retirement Fund, we constantly monitor manager performance and make adjustments as required. The Fund ended 2010 at \$160,002,302.26 with the County's annual contribution being \$2,265,930 for a net increase of approximately \$11 million. We will continue our diligence to maintain and insure that the retirement fund remains a stable and ongoing reliable source of retirement income for the employees, and retirees of Cambria County Government.
