### Salary Board in Session.

Salary Board in session. Commissioners Thomas C. Chernisky, William J. Smith, Scott W. Hunt, and Ed Cernic, Jr., Controller, were present.

Call to Order was made by President Commissioner Chernisky, in the Jury Room of the Cambria County Courthouse, at 10:00 a.m.

Motion was made by Commissioner Smith to waive the reading of the Salary Board Minutes of March 19, 2020, but to approve them and place them on file.

### Public Comment:

John DeBartola questioned if the County had enough money and if people were paying their taxes due to Covid-19. He stated that he is worried about the County paying employees, when they aren't working every day, and what position that will put the County in at the end of the year, when employees are trying to use their vacation time, etc. He is concerned that the County will have a budgetary shortfall at the end of the year.

#### Create:

Motion was made by Controller Cernic to create a Per-Diem Clerk Typist I for Voter Registration, (Paygrade 3-A/\$10.00 per hour), effective April 27, 2020. This creation is contingent upon full-time employees working and not utilizing M5 time and will be effective through June 3, 2020.

Motion was seconded by Commissioner Smith and passed unanimously.

#### Salary Modification:

Motion was made by Controller Cernic to modify the salary of the Full-Time Human Resources Specialist for Human Resources, (Paygrade 49-Z/\$36,000.00 annually) to (Paygrade 49-Z/\$31,500.00 annually), effective April 27, 2020.

Motion was seconded by Commissioner Smith and passed unanimously.

Motion was made by Controller Cernic to modify the salary of the Per-Diem Clerk Typist I for Voter Registration, (Paygrade 3-A/\$8.42 per hour) to (Paygrade 3-A/\$10.00 per hour), effective April 27, 2020, through June 3, 2020.

Motion was seconded by Commissioner Smith and passed unanimously.

Controller Cernic requested that the Commissioners not fill positions at this time.
