

"QUALIFIED PROFESSIONALS" under the Divorce Code are defined as follows:

"Includes marriage counselors, psychologists, psychiatrists, social workers, ministers, priests, or rabbis, or other persons who, by virtue of their training and experience, are able to provide counseling."

The choice of a qualified professional shall be at the option of the parties and such professional need not be selected from the list provided by the Court.

The cost of the counseling services should be agreed upon between the parties and the counselor at the outset. The Court, of course, cannot dictate the fee for services.

If the parties are indigent and desire counseling, that should be revealed at the outset to the Counselor and in the event the Counselor cannot provide the service, the Court encourages the Counselor to refer the parties to an appropriate agency for such counseling or the parties may seek counseling through an appropriate agency or service unilaterally.
