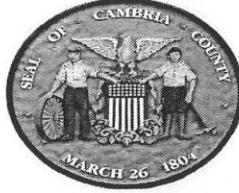

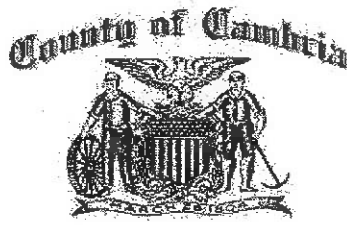

OPERATIONS:

MAJOR MAINTENANCE / FACILITIES UPDATES:

Kronos Time Keeping Software - Still testing software. Anticipated go-live date has been pushed back to February 2024.

Hot Water Tank - the last of the four hot water tanks that were installed in 2019 has failed and is in need of replacement. Cost is \$17,475.00 and the tank is currently on order.

Viapath/GTL - inmate tablet update and installation completed 11/29/23. We went live with the new software on December 5th. This update will give the inmates increased access to law library materials, additional educational resources, and their personal mail (not legal mail) will now be delivered to them digitally.

INMATE SERVICES

Through our inmate Canteen Fund, we purchased 40 copies of a new treatment book entitled "No Addict Left Behind" to distribute among our housing unit libraries. Each housing unit received 6 copies of the book to share among the inmate population. The author is Joey Pagano, MSW, LSW, CRS, who is a recovering addict and project supervisor at the SPSHS Center of Excellence in southwestern Pennsylvania. A printout of his social media post regarding our purchase is included with this packet.

CHRISTMAS DONATION

LBCB Next Steps, an independent Bible non-denominational church located in Manhiem, PA, reached out to correctional facilities throughout the state asking if we would be willing to accept Christmas 'Hope Packs' for both inmates and staff. The inmate Hope Pack include items such as a journal, a calendar, a puzzle book, and a pre-paid postage card. All inmates will receive one

package each. A separate Hope Pack containing different items will be distributed to staff. We would like to thank LBCB Next Steps for their generous donation.

PA PRISON SOCIETY

The Pennsylvania Prison Society's Bi-Annual Data Collection report is attached for the board's review. We were one of the 38 counties who responded to their request for information.

POSSIBLE SOLAR PROJECT

On November 30th, we met with Bruce Mancini from Tremco (the company that did our roof) and a representative from The BAI Group, a civil/environmental/and geological consultant group. The two have partnered on rooftop solar projects and wanted to discuss a possible solar array on the prison's roof that their preliminary data shows a possible 30% savings in electricity. The solar panels would be secured to the roof by weighted ballasts with no penetration to the new roof, all maintenance would be covered, and the rooftop warranty would not be affected. The project would involve no initial cost to the county, however the county would have to agree to a specified time period to purchase the solar power. They are gathering more detailed data and we plan to meet again soon. If the project seems promising, we will forward the information to the commissioner's office to review. If and when a decision is made to move forward with RFP's, we would suggest an engineering study of the roof be completed first to ensure it can bear the extra weight.

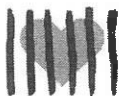
We received full or partial responses from 38 counties.

Thirty-two out of 38 counties are open for in-person visits.

- Despite research that contact visits, particularly between incarcerated parents and their children, are exceptionally important, only four out of the 38 responding counties are currently allowing any contact visits. Consistent with best practices, Tioga County offers general contact visits. The other three – Mifflin, Clinton, and Beaver counties – only allow contact visits with children.

Nearly half (15 out of 32) of the prisons that answered questions on security staffing levels had vacancy rates of 10 percent or higher for full-time security staff.

- Five prisons had vacancy rates of 25 percent or higher: Armstrong, Bradford, Chester, Clinton, Venango.
- This staffing picture is similar to what we found one year ago.
- Twelve prisons – Blair, Clarion, Elk, Jefferson, Lawrence, McKean, Mifflin, Montour, Perry, Susquehanna, Tioga, and Union – reported having a full complement of full-time security staff.

More than half (12 out of 20) of the prisons that answered questions on medical staffing levels reported having a full complement of full-time medical staff.

- Eight of 15 prisons that reported having part-time medical staff had all part-time positions filled.

All but two out of 36 prisons that answered questions about medical copays reported charging a medical copay, a practice opposed by the National Commission on Correctional Health Care because of the barriers it places on access to needed care and because of the impact it has on families in poverty.¹

- The copays ranged from \$5 to \$10 for a doctor visit, and \$3 to \$5 for a nurse visit.
- Several counties also reported charging a copay for prescription drugs.
- In keeping with best practice, Union and Venango counties do not charge a medical copay.
- Medical copays often deter incarcerated people from seeking necessary medical care, which can increase the spread of infectious diseases like COVID-19 and result in higher overall costs for medical care.^{2 3 4}
- The National Commission on Correctional Health Care states: “Because of their disproportionate poverty and incidence of drug use, inmates have higher morbidity and mortality from treatable serious medical problems. Therefore, NCCHC is opposed

to the establishment of a fee-for-service or co-payment program that restricts patient access to care.”⁵

Twenty-one out of 37 counties that responded to questions about chaplain services reported having a designated chaplain.

- The prisons’ designated chaplains are a mix of employees, contractors, and volunteers.

Our next rounds of calls will be in February. We will be asking questions about medical contracting and offering counties an opportunity to receive technical assistance on contracting for medical services. We will also be asking about practices regarding people with mental health, and compensation for incarcerated workers.

As always, we thank you for the opportunity to be of service in the shared work of safeguarding the health, safety and dignity of people in prison, and by extension, the health, safety and dignity of people who work in prison.

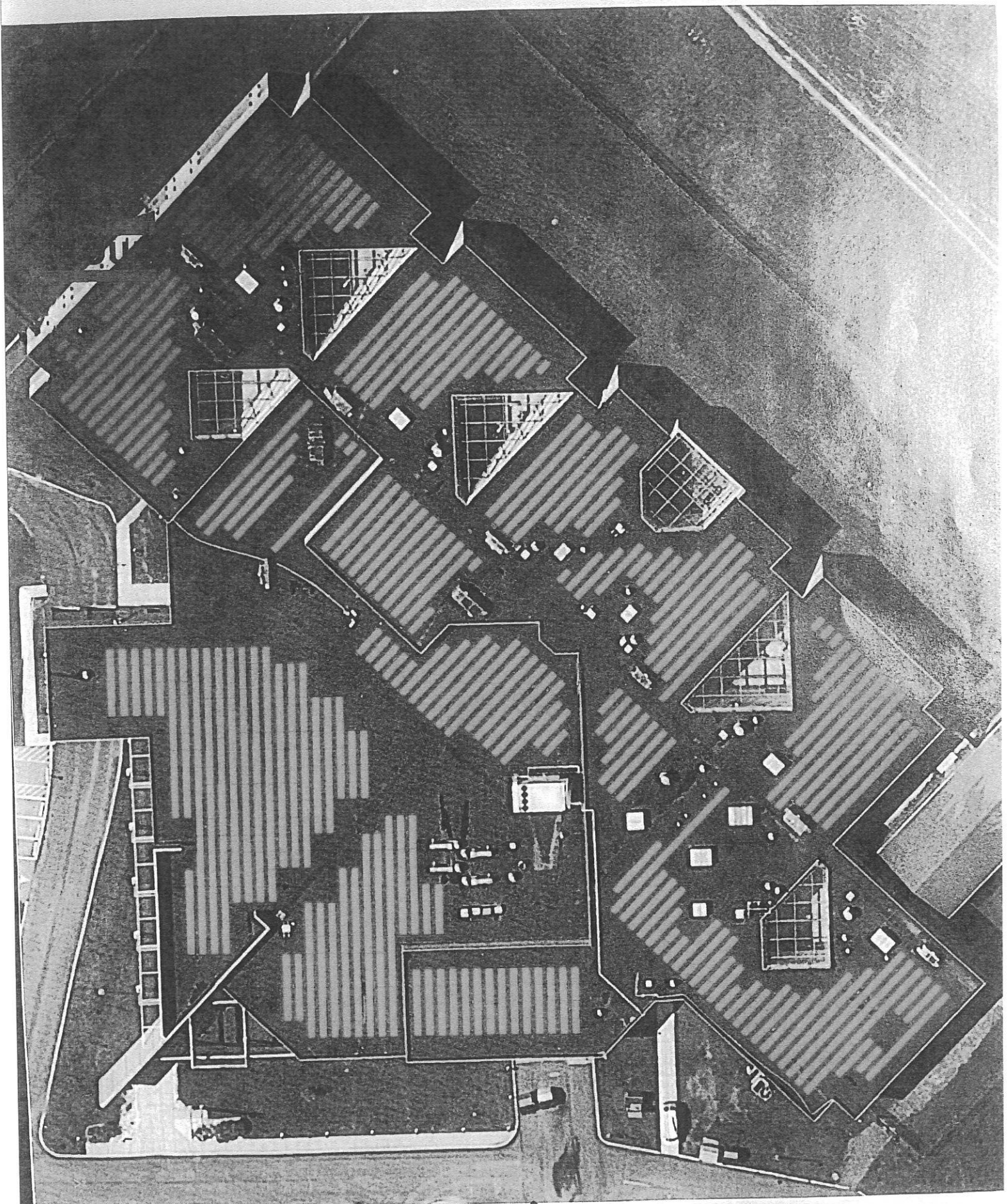
