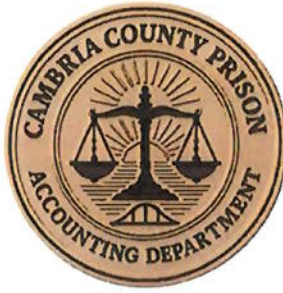

Prison Board Meeting Warden's Report

Board Meeting: September 10, 2025

Executive Session:

Operations:

Supervisory Positions:

- With the newly appointed Captain positions, we have begun implementing a fully revamped system of supervision within the prison. For many years, the distinction between the roles of Lieutenant and Captain was little more than a matter of title. Today, that separation is being defined with clear authority, responsibility, and oversight to strengthen accountability at every level.
- We have developed a set of "post orders" for both Lieutenants and Captains—going beyond generalized job descriptions. These post orders are the first of their kind at our facility. We are also in the process of establishing specific criteria for each position, ensuring the chain of command is clearly defined. This initiative will strengthen operations by providing clear ownership of responsibilities, giving staff greater clarity, and streamlining checks and balances throughout the prison. This change in policy has been communicated to all staff.
- We converted the former print shop into a dedicated Lieutenant's office. Using repurposed resources, each Lieutenant now has their own computer, desk, and phone extension, with equipment provided entirely through unused county inventory. The only expense to the county was the addition of one printer to our existing contract and approximately \$100 for paint to refresh a room that had not been painted in decades.
- The former office space in the staff muster area, once shared by all seven shift supervisors, has now been converted into a dedicated Captain's office. This was accomplished entirely with repurposed resources—desks from the old domestic building, the last of the prison's unused computers, and an additional phone provided by county IT. This upgrade provides ownership to each of our Supervisors and firmly re-establishes the chain of command.

Operations:

Supervisory Positions (continued):

- A swearing-in ceremony was held at the courthouse for our Captains, Lieutenants, Food Service Director, Maintenance Supervisor, and Re-Entry Coordinator. This marked the first time that all of our Shift Commanders stood together outside the facility at the same time. The ceremony reinforced the pride of stepping into a leadership role, strengthened teamwork among our administrators, and sent a clear message to our Correctional Officers that hard work and dedication are recognized and rewarded.

Staffing:

- Unfortunately, we did lose a few cadets from the academy. Three full-time Officers resigned from the class, but they were immediately replaced by two per-diem staff. One per-diem was removed, and three retirees ultimately decided not to return as planned. That said, we continue to move forward with two per-diem Officers who are college students, five retiree per-diems, and remain on track to be one full-time Officer short of full staffing levels once the current academy class graduates.
- Our retiree per-diem Officers will primarily be assigned to medical transports and to assist with job shadowing and training new Corrections Officers after the academy class. While the initial plan was to use them during all job shadowing, a more fiscally responsible approach is to assign them only when their presence prevents another Officer from being mandated. This strategy maintains effective training while further reducing overtime costs.
- Coordinator Mary McCoy officially began her role as Re-Entry Coordinator on August 25, 2025. Goodwill has also posted the position of Re-Entry Specialist to complement her work. In addition, we are finalizing the development of the new Department of Custody and Community Integration, located in the former video courtroom, to support and facilitate the important work these two positions will lead.
- We have posted the open Counselor position created by Coordinator McCoy's transition, as well as the vacant Director of Training and Recruitment position. In addition, interviews for the Chaplain role are scheduled to take place in the coming week.

Major Maintenance / Facility Updates

- Intertech has completed the replacement server and software upgrade. The camera system is now operating better than ever, and the upgrade provides enhanced security for the inmate population and greater safety for staff.
- The thaw box in the kitchen has been replaced by K&D and is now fully operational. This upgrade resolves long-standing issues with food storage and preparation, ensuring reliability for daily meal service and improved efficiency in kitchen operations.

Federal Surplus

- In an effort to reduce costs, the prison obtained equipment through the Federal Surplus program. To meet the mandate for dual authentication, 24 brand-new computers were purchased at \$150 each. With comparable models typically priced at \$700-\$800 apiece, this purchase generated savings of over \$13,000 for the prison budget.
- The air conditioning system in the Lieutenant's office was quoted at approximately \$9,000 to replace. Instead, we purchased two floor air conditioning units from surplus at \$95 each, effectively resolving the temperature issue at a fraction of the cost. This approach provided immediate relief while avoiding a substantial expense to the county.
- We purchased 20 office chairs at \$20 each to replace the worn-out chairs in offices and control centers. This cost-effective solution addressed an immediate need while providing significant savings compared to standard replacement costs.

Operations (continued):**Audits / Inspections**

- The results of the 2025 PREA audit have been received, and the prison has officially passed. In the final report, we exceeded five standards and met all 40 required standards, reflecting full compliance and a strong commitment to safety and accountability.
- The United States Marshals Service conducted an inspection of the facility and reported no issues. They also noted that there were minimal complaints from federal detainees—an improvement from their last visit, when complaints had been more prevalent.
- We are in the final stages of contracting with an Inspector to conduct a comprehensive audit of the facility and the training department. This voluntary audit is intended to proactively identify and address potential issues before they arise. The cost will be covered through the inmate rehabilitation fund, as the audit directly supports inmate safety and overall welfare.

Inmate Treatment

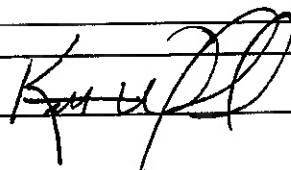
- We held a Re-Entry work session with Goodwill, Cambria County Drug and Alcohol, Cambria County Probation, and Cambria County Behavioral Health at the Day Reporting Center. During the meeting, eligibility criteria for referrals to the Re-Entry Program were established. These sessions will continue on a quarterly basis to ensure the program's ongoing success and to address any challenges that arise.
- The Re-Entry team will be conducting a site visit to Dauphin County in October to observe their Re-Entry Department firsthand. This visit is intended to gather insights into proven practices that have been effective in another county, allowing us to identify strategies we can adapt and implement here. By learning from the successes of others, we are taking a proactive step toward strengthening our own Re-Entry Program and improving outcomes for those we serve.
- Smarter Parents, a county-based group that facilitates educational programs for parents, will be meeting with the Administrative staff to review program materials prior to introducing them to the inmate population. This collaboration is designed to ensure that the content is appropriate, effective, and aligns with the needs of those in our care. By providing incarcerated parents with tools and education to strengthen family relationships, the program will not only support successful re-entry but also help create greater stability for their children and families in the community.
- A services fair is scheduled for September 19, marking the first event of its kind at the prison. The fair will bring together community partners and service providers to connect directly with inmates, offering resources to support their transition back into the community. This initiative represents a major step forward in strengthening our Re-Entry efforts and ensuring that inmates have access to the tools and support needed for long-term success.

Miscellaneous:

- A meeting was held with all of the County Magistrates in order to develop a system to streamline court transports and to address needs of both the prison and the court system.

During the month of August, I have worked directly with the inmates. I am teaching them how to properly follow prep lists and recipes; this will help eliminate waste by not over prepping food. I am also teaching them the essentials of food safety, such as, temperature danger zones, sanitation and the food storage hierarchy.

I did reduce spending in the month of August, however, our dishwasher broke on Sept 1st and it was down for thirteen days. The total cost of extra supplies (Styrofoam trays, cups, sporks, etc.) for this time period was \$5,115, which increased the total purchases for August compared to July. Without this unexpected expense, I would have reduced the cost per tray by eight cents.
