**Commissioners in Session.** Commissioners Scott W. Hunt, Keith Rager, and Thomas C. Chernisky were present.

The Commissioners' Meeting was called to Order by President Commissioner Scott W. Hunt, in the Jury Room of the Cambria County Courthouse, at 10:04 a.m.

**Public Comment:**

John DeBartola asked what the CFA Grant was for and commented on the Election Integrity Grant. He also commented on the action involving Dinsmore & Shohl, bond counsel, asking what money the County has on hand and what is due to be paid out. He also questioned if the County would be paying for the Westmont Goucher Street Sports Complex.

Edward Cernic, Jr., Controller, handed out the Annual Financial Report put together by his office, which is also available on the County's website. He spoke about the amount of money the County has on hand along with the outstanding bills.

Motion was made by Commissioner Rager to waive the reading of the Minutes of the Commissioners' Meeting held July 24, 2025, but to approve them and place them on file.
