Motion was made by Commissioner Rager to create a Full-Time Temporary Accounting Assistant I for the Controller's Office, (Paygrade 11-D/\$13.26 [1820 hours] per hour), effective October 27, 2025.

Motion was seconded by Commissioner Chernisky and passed with a 3 to 1 vote. Controller Cernic voted yes, and Commissioner Hunt voted no.

Motion was made by Commissioner Rager to create three (3) Per-Diem Election Worker positions for Voter Registration, (Paygrade 3-S/\$12.00 [1000 hours] per hour), effective October 27, 2025, through November 14, 2025.
