RE: Act No. 152 of 2016 - Demolition Fee

On January 26, 2017 the Cambria County Commissioners passed a Resolution to implement Act No. 152 of 2016 - Recorders Fee Law - Additional Fee Imposed and Used for Demolition.

Act No. 152 of 2016 was approved and signed by Pennsylvania Governor Tom Wolf on November 4, 2016. This Act enables county commissioners in Pennsylvania to pass a resolution or create an ordinance, and authorize the county recorder of deeds to charge and collect a fee not to exceed \$15.00 for each deed and mortgage recorded.

This fee will be deposited into the county Demolition Fund to be used exclusively for the demolition of blighted properties situate in the county.

Effective March 1, 2017 an additional \$15.00 will be collected for every deed and mortgage recorded.
